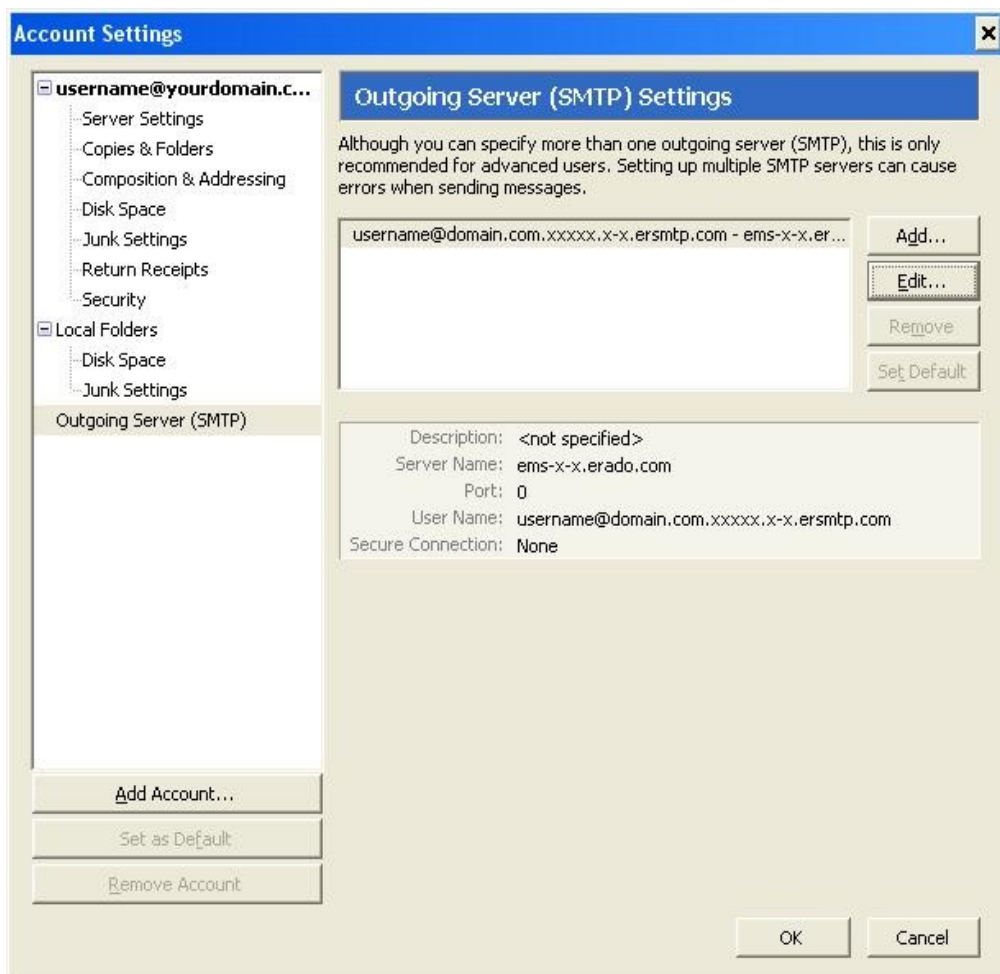




Thunderbird SecureMail Configuration

This document applies to individual ersmtp.com accounts only. If you do not have an ersmtp.com account provided by Erado DO NOT USE these instructions.

1. Click the Tools menu and select Account Settings
Then click “**Outgoing Server (SMTP)**” from the left pane



2. Highlight your account and click “edit”



3. Change the "Server Name" to the server name provided in your "SecureMail Starter Kit".
4. Change the "User Name" to the user name provided in your "SecureMail Starter Kit".
5. Check the "TLS" radio button.
